- For all University logins, the username is your **University ID** in the following format, for example:
[12345678](#)
- The password is your University network password (Date-of-Birth e.g. 10Jan01 – until you **reset it**)

Multi-Factor Authentication



- When using your own device, or non-campus WiFi, you'll have to use Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA).
- Simplest method: install the Microsoft Authenticator App which will send you a prompt when accessing university services.

Wi-Fi around the university



- University Wi-Fi network: **'eduroam'**
- The login username is your **University** email address
12345678@stu.mmu.ac.uk
- The password is your **University network password**
- Use eduroam instead of the guest Wi-Fi; it auto-authenticates many pages/systems
- Many universities use the eduroam network; you can connect at another institution by logging in with your university credentials.

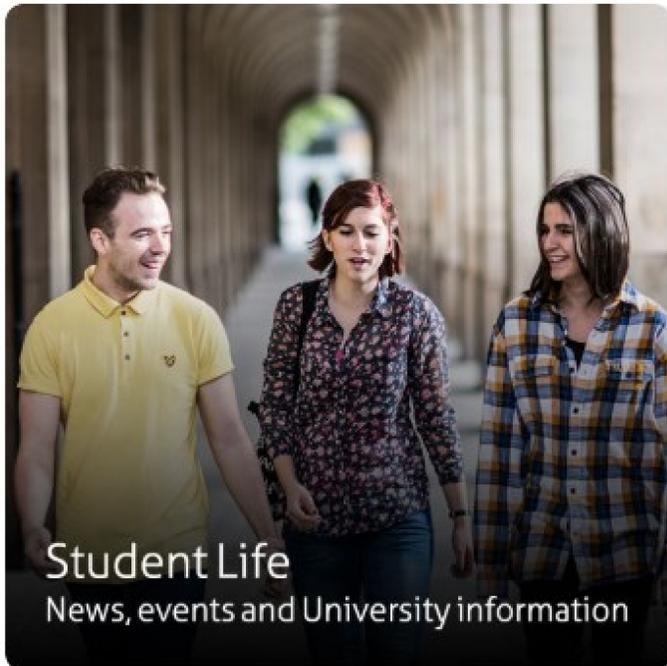
MyMMU App

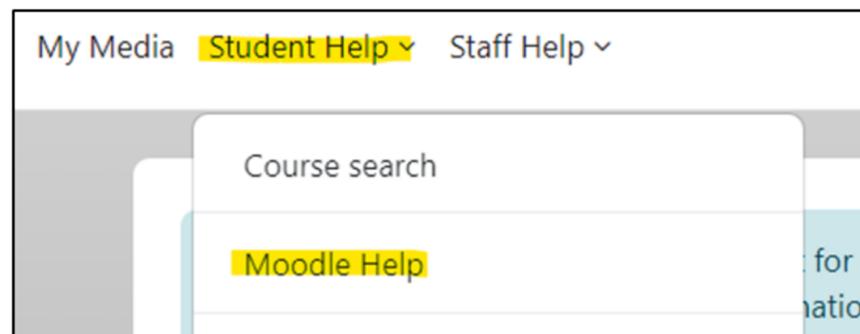

Microsoft Office 365 & Adobe Express

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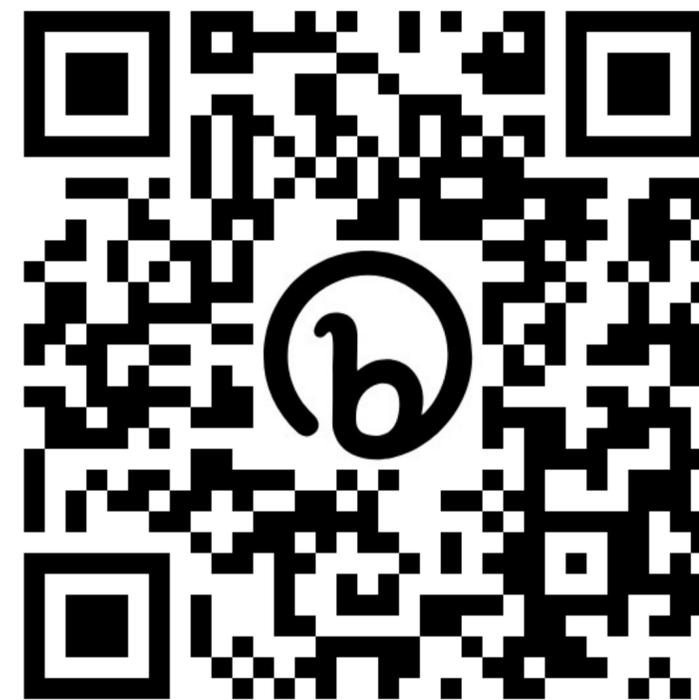
- All students at Manchester Met have access to the Office 365 suite of applications: Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, and more
- You can access the web versions, or download Office applications onto your personal device to use throughout the duration of your course.
- You can also access Adobe Express via the MyMMU App.

Microsoft OneDrive

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- OneDrive is free for all students at Manchester Met. OneDrive provides a large file storage area that you can access from any device via your web browser or a downloadable app.

- OneDrive is the recommended storage solution for your university work



Microsoft Outlook



- Outlook is our main tool for email communications.

- Staff operate a 72-hour response time for emails.
- Email is **the most common** way to contact your tutors.
